



COFFEE CAN DRUM

What You Need:

- An empty coffee can with a plastic lid (small, large, whatever you have).
- Construction paper, glue & scissors.
- Paint or markers.
- Paintbrushes & water.
- Sticks
- String, leather, feathers, beads ... any bits of scrap material you might have.

What You Do:

1. Cover the coffee can with construction paper. Leave the plastic lid on the coffee can ... this will be your drum head.
2. Paint or draw designs and creatures on the coffee can.
3. After the paint is dry, you can glue all sorts of wonderful things to your drum.
4. Using wooden sticks, drum away on your new coffee can drum.



DOG HOUSE FOR A BEANIE ANIMAL

What You Need:

- Teeny Bean Bag Animal
- Empty Half Gallon Milk Carton (paper carton)
- Paint
- Pictures of Bean Bag Animals from magazines or printed from Ty's web site
- Glue Stick & Hot Glue Gun
- Scissors

What You Do:

- Wash and dry the milk carton.
- Cut off the top third of the house. This is the only part you will need.
- Hot glue the container closed.
- Cut an arched opening in the front for the door.
- Paint the carton & Let Dry
- Decorate with stickers, drawings or any way you want



OCEAN IN A BOTTLE

What You Need:

- An empty plastic bottle with labels removed
- Food Coloring
- Glitter
- Water & Oil

What You Do:

- Fill the bottle; ½ with oil (such as canola) and half with water
- Add food coloring and glitter
- You can also add small beads if handy
- Shake and enjoy



SNEAKY SNAKE

What You Need:

- 3 empty TP tubes
- Paint & Brush
- Glue
- Hole Puncher, Scissors
- Small scraps of red paper
- Paper clip
- String
- Wiggly eyes or black marker

What You Do:

- Cut empty tp tubes in half.
- Paint the inside a light color such as green or yellow
- Paint a darker color in the middle of each ring and lighter color near the edges. Let Dry
- Paint a rough black line where the colors meet.
- Punch a hole in each roll near each edge.
- Hook pieces together (both ends) using paper clips.
- Cut a forked tongue out of red paper. Glue tongue to one end.
- On the same end, glue on two wiggly eyes. Add a string to pull him around.
